
AUTHOR'S CHECKLIST

- The corresponding author (or the representative author of the co-corresponding authors) is the submitter of this manuscript.
 - A cover letter is prepared (it should be submitted during the submission process).
 - A copyright form includes signatures of all co-authors.
 - The main text font is Times New Roman of 12 pt size.
 - Manuscript is double-spaced in A4-size pages.
 - Manuscript includes line numbers.
 - Manuscript includes abstracts (except Editorials and Letter to the editors).
 - Title page and the rest of the manuscript text are prepared separately in two files (not combined together).
 - A running title (not to exceed 45 characters including spaces and punctuation) is provided if the whole title exceeds 12 words.
 - For original articles, a structured abstract of no more than 250 words under the following headings is attached: Background/Aims, Methods, Results, and Conclusions.
 - Key words (5 or less) are provided in the manuscript. The key words are following the style of MeSH. These are submitted during the submission process.
 - References are in the correct style (please download and refer to the "JNM Endnote Style").
 - *In the text, citation number should be superscripted without parentheses after period.
 - *In the reference list, list all authors if the number of authors is less than 7 and list first 3 authors followed by "et al" if the number of authors is 7 or more. Names of journals should be abbreviated in the style used in Index Medicus (not italic).
- Example:

 2. Borges LF, Jagadeesan V, Goldberg H, et al. Abnormal bolus reflux is associated with poor pulmonary outcome in patients with idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis. *J Neurogastroenterol Motil* 2018;24:395-402.
- Tables may either be uploaded separately or included at the end of the manuscript as editable text and not as images.
 - Figure files are prepared separately. Figure legends are included in the manuscript file after the Reference section.
 - Manuscript includes a mention of Tables and Figures or Supplementary materials (if necessary).
 - The statistical difference (*P*-value) should be expressed as 3 digits below zero.
 - Photographic images should be submitted in TIFF, JPEG, PNG, and GIF format with the original high-resolution. It should have a minimum width of 100 mm and a minimum resolution of 300 dpi. Line-arts (graphs and illustrations) should be submitted in native PPT (preferred) including editable figure elements, TIFF files (at least 300 dpi with a minimum width of 100 mm).
